Sulutane

In the last edition we reported that the community had started digging the foundations for the new preschool building and toilets at Sulutane. The walls are on their way up and Johannes reports:

“On 13 November 2023 I went to Sulutane to assess the extent of construction of the Preschool Hall. I discovered that they had finished footing and laying three courses of cement blocks. They were backfilling and had received one truck load of gravel waiting for two more loads to complete. Owing to continuous rainfall, the truck could not deliver the gravel. When it delivered the first load, it was stuck near the new structure. It rained all day today, but it should be clear soon. Hopefully the remaining gravel will be delivered soon.





All the necessary materials are on site; thus, work should proceed as soon as it stops raining and the ground becomes firm enough for the truck to reach the site. I expect remarkable progress over the next week or so.”

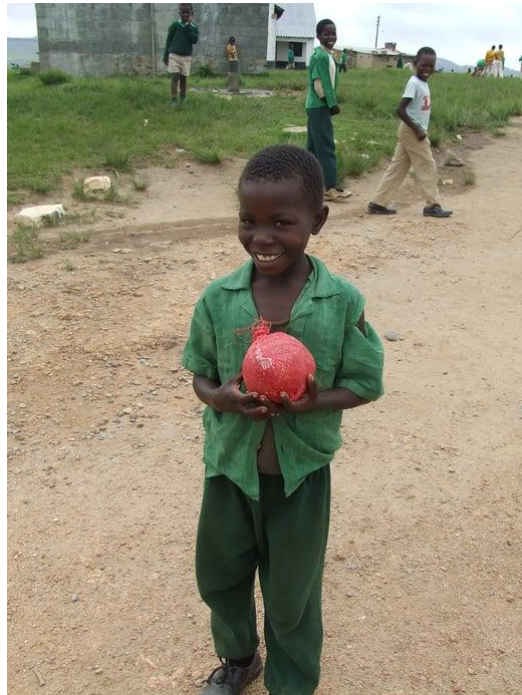
