

THE JOY FOUNDATION is a local Christian charity that works in 23 primary aged schools in the Lincoln area. We are supported by many local churches and individuals through prayer and finance. We also receive greatly valued support by the schools themselves and through grant applications. Here's a quick look at what we do.



COLLECTIVE WORSHIP

The Joy Foundation leads high quality, regular Collective Worship that is linked with school vision, values and planning. These are rooted in the Bible, encouraging spiritual and moral development. These are usually provided monthly but in some schools are provided more regularly. TJF also runs an online joint schools Collective Worship three times a year called **TOGETHER!**

MENTORING

There is a growing need for mentoring support amongst local children. Support with emotional needs is particularly required and TJF provides this support in schools with our trained Schoolworker.



COLLECTIVE WORSHIP COUNCILS

TJF provides bespoke packages to support pupil Collective Worship Councils. These involve exploring what is Collective Worship, understanding the 4 elements of Gather, Engage, Respond and Send and developing the children's ability to lead Collective Worship. These are usually presented in a workshop style on a monthly basis.

CLUBS

TJF leads two types of extra-curricular clubs.

KS2 Challenge Club is based around Physical, Practical and Personal Challenges that keep the children engaged, active and provoke reflection on what is presented through Collective Worship and school values.

KS1 Fun Club is an interactive, fast paced, joyful club that has social games, stories, activities and challenges that engage children and help them to learn about the Bible



BIBLE ROADSHOWS



The Bible Roadshow is where the big story of the Bible is told through 7 interactive stories in the space of an hour. This is presented to small groups, giving children the chance to engage in and respond to the Bible challenges.

SCHOOL REQUESTS

TJF also provides schools with bespoke needs, such as staff training in Collective Worship, Church School Inspection support and Governing Body assistance. TJF also supports school special events such as Harvest Festivals, Christmas, Easter and Leaver's Events.
